

I would like a balloon arch, what size or type do I request?

The **SIZE of a Balloon Arch** is determined by various formulas. Miss-calculating could result in disaster. Let us guide you through the following steps to ensure success.

1. Decide where you would like the balloon arch to be placed (doorway entrance, driveway entrance, backdrop for a stage or head table, etc.)
2. Measure exact (don't estimate) the width you want the arch to span and the height (at the center) you will need (for clearance) to cover the area. (width + height = total length)
3. Indicate how much room you have for the arch (such as the distance between back wall and chairs or between the back of stage and the DJ, or is it an open area). This will determine the depth as to which type of arch will work best in that area.

There are several types of balloon arches to consider-

1. Packed Balloon Arch – 4 to 6 balloons per row. Patterns can vary – spiral or twisted, alternate stacked color, arrow, flower, zigzag, polka dots, stars and stripes, solid color, alternate size pack
2. String of Pearl Arch – Single balloons on an arch line
3. Zipper or Backbone Arch – Single balloons with a duplet of balloons (like wings) alternating
4. Topiary Ball Arch – clusters of balloons to form a ball spaced strategically on an arch line
5. Name Arch – Using Foil Letters or Numbers on an arch line
6. Link-o-Loon Arch – Special type of balloons which have an end on both top and bottom of the balloon so they could link together without using an arch line
